The Trauma Program Manager will be responsible for the organization of the trauma services and systems necessary for a Multi-Disciplinary approach to providing optimal care to injured patients.

Job Description:

- Leads in *clinical activities* by coordinating and managing care across the continuum of trauma care.
- *Educational responsibilities* providing intrafacility and regional professional staff development, participates in case reviews and implementation of practice guidelines.
- Oversees the *Trauma Performance Improvement* processes while maintaining confidentiality.
- *Administrative role* managing operations, personnels and the fiscal aspects of the trauma program. Serves as a liaison to administration, and represents the program on various internal and external committees to enhance and foster optimal trauma care management.
- *Supervision of the trauma registry’s* coding, scoring and developing processes for validation of data by incorporating the performance improvement process through tracking and trending of reports.
- *Consultant and liaison* to the program through assisting and stabilizing the complex network of multiple disciplines that work in concert to provide optimal care.
- *Community and National* involvement in the trauma system.
- Reports directly to the Trauma Medical Director.

Experienced in Trauma Clinical Care leadership

TNCC or ATCN certification is required.

BLS, PALS and ACLS certification required.
