Preferred qualifications include:

- College education and health care experience preferred
- Experience with basic knowledge of anatomy and physiology , medical terminology and medical record coding
- Data abstraction and computer data entry skills a plus
- Certified Trauma Registrar preferred
- Initiative and motivation are key factors for this position. Employee needs to be able to work independently, and use skills to develop internal and external relationships.
